

Welmoed Selection Pinotage 1999

Vivid ruby-red colour. Delicious round, raspberry and ripe fruit nose. Good, solid entrance with well-structured mid-palate and in-mouth berry flavours and elegant tannin finish.

in the vineyard : Grapes are sourced from old ($\hat{A}\pm$ 30 years) and low bearing (7 tons/ha) bush vines to ensure complex, well-structured fruit. The must is fermented on skins for $\hat{A}\pm$ 3 days when the juice is drawn off at 10 \hat{A} °Balling. Maturation takes place in third fill French oak barrels for 12 months.
