Is characterised by its upfront red berry and raisin flavour which is full blown, rich and sweet on the palate. Alcohol gives full palate strength.

in the vineyard : Soil: The grapes come from our higher potential deep red hutton types. All vineyards are unirrigated bush vine.

Climate: The Swartland falls within the coastal winter rainfall area. Warm, dry summers, moderated by cool Atlantic breezes.

Annual rainfall: 400mm average

about the harvest: Pinotage grapes, which are full ripe with sugars above 25° Balling, are chosen for Red Jerepigo.
