Pale, bright gold with green reflections. Expansive nose blossoming with youth and bursting fresh bouquet on the nose. Heaps of fresh, ripe, sweet fruit in the mouth with jangle of brisk acidity. Intense and almost like a stropo young teenager full of vigour yet still has the breeding to tone down and develop over a year or two. Enjoy now in the exuberance of youth and follow its development over next few years

in the cellar : Bunch selection was done in the vineyard. The grapes were left on the skins over night, and lightly pressed. After settling the juice was racked and inoculated with VIN13. Fermentation took place at 13°C to ensure a fruity wine that will linger in your memory.
