

DMZ Concerto 2009

Deep core, bright rim. Nose takes a while to get into gear then goes into overdrive with full delivery of ripe plum, mulberry, espresso and freshly ground, black pepper. Behind the full aromatic flourish is a delightful floral fragrance of red rose and some violet. Rich and full flavoured in the mouth with already a smooth yet lively flow across the palate. Good, yet supple tannic backbone. Seductive and very appealing. Delightful, floral note in long finish. Easy to drink now yet has great development potential and should be allowed to develop. Enjoy now and over the next four to six years.

ageing : This wine is drinking very well now, will improve over the next four years and should last for many more to come

in the vineyard : These vineyards are situated on the farm De Morgenzon in the Stellenbosch kloof. Planted in 2004 the trellised vineyard is managed to ensured natural high acidity and full flavor concentration. The yield was 5,8 (30hl/ha only free - run juice used) tons per hectare.

about the harvest: The grapes were handpicked and selected in the early morning at between 24.0° and 24.8° Balling. The yield was 5,8 (30hl/ha - only free-run juice used) tons per hectare with acids above 7,0 g/l and pH's generally below 3,1.
