

## Plaisir De Merle Sauvignon Blanc 1999

It shows crisp grapefruit and herbaceous tones on the nose and sweet tropical fruit on the taste. This extends to a mouthfilling, lingering aftertaste.

**about the harvest:** Characteristically, the grapes for the Plaisir de Merle Sauvignon Blanc were harvested at full ripeness.

**in the cellar :** With the emphasis on secondary flavours, the wine was fermented in stainless steel tanks, but left on the lees for four months to develop complexity.
