

Steenberg Motif Rouge 1999

This easy drinking red wine is medium bodied with distinct ripe berry aromas, complemented by gentle oak. These aromas are carried through onto the palate creating a well balanced, structured and rewarding wine.

about the harvest: A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. The grapes were harvested at a sugar level of 24.5°B.

in the cellar : After de-stalking and crushing the bunches, the grapes were pumped into stainless steel fermentation tanks and inoculated with a cultured yeasts. Fermentation temperature was controlled at 25°C. After the grapes had fermented dry, they were pressed and the wine then underwent malo-lactic fermentation. After malo-lactic fermentation was complete, the wine was then matured in French oak barriques for 12 months. The wine was then blended in proportions of Merlot (35%) and Cabernet Sauvignon (65%).
