

## Leopard's Leap Cabernet Sauvignon 2010

Wine style: Medium-bodied, elegant, New World style.

Nose: Rich blueberry and plum flavours with mocha undertones.

Palate: Elegant with a ripe but dry tannin structure and a lingering aftertaste.

**variety** : Cabernet Sauvignon | 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

**in the vineyard** : Selective grape selection from Perdeberg, Swartland and Wellington region.

**in the cellar** : Standard fermentation with selective yeast accompanied by pump-overs and punch-downs at 28 degrees Celsius. Extended skin maceration, pressed and post fermentation malolactic.

### Aging

55% of the wine was matured in 225-litre French oak barrels. Balance of the wine was oak staved for 6 months with added micro-oxygenation.
