

Morgenhof Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 1998

This wine has a deep ruby red colour. The nose has different layers of flavour on predominantly cassis, black current and black berries. This concentrated fruity flavours follows through on the palate where youâ€™ll find them in good balance with the wood flavours. The tannins are fruity and soft. This wine will go well with most red meat prepared in a various ways. Other suggestions include rich fish, chicken casseroles, pasta dishes and cheeses.
