This wine drinks like a cappacino. With a slight residual sugar and warmth on the palate this wine is the ideal accompaniment to any furnace in winter time.

Rich coffee, mocha, chocolaty nose.

Undertones of dark fruit, ripe berries and cacao on the palate.

Drink it on it's own, with spicy foods (curry) or pasta dishes. It is also a perfect after-dinner-wine. The sweetness will go very well with a rich and creamy dessert.
