

## Porcupine Ridge Syrah / Viognier 2010

Intense red colour with dark fruit, spice and perfume on the nose. Soft accessible tannins with a velvety smooth finish on the palate. A well structured wine with integrated use of oak and lingering mouth feel.

**variety :** Shiraz | 94% Syrah, 6% Viognier

**in the vineyard :** Syrah and Viognier grapes were sourced from Malmesbury in the renowned Swartland region.

**about the harvest:** The Syrah was picked at optimum ripeness to secure opulent spice and structure in the blend and the Viognier was picked uber ripe for perfume and added silkiness.

**in the cellar :** The wine was fermented in stainless steel and aged in French Oak barrels before filtration and bottling.
