in the vineyard : Vine density – 4,500 vines per hectare.

about the harvest: The best quality grapes were selected and picked at optimum tannin ripeness.

in the cellar : Grapes were gently crushed and fermented in stainless steel tanks. The wine matured for 15 months in small, third-fill French- and American oak barrels.
