

Bovlei Mad Hatters Carignan 2010 (Discontinued)

Fresh and lively, High acidity, Raspberry and cherry, Robust tannins, Astringent

A hint of cherry with some rustic Old World nuance. Balanced acids make this wine fresh and appealing as a summer red wine.

Steak & chips, venison and sweet potatoes, grilled pork chops.

in the cellar : 15 tons were fermented in a roto-tank after which the wine was aged for 12 months in a 4 000 litre barrel to which American oak staves were added. Before bottling, the wine was refreshed by adding a small percentage of a fresher vintage wine.
