

Wildeckrans Shiraz 2009

Purple colour with a ruby tinge. This elegant wine has a complex nose of cinnamon, fynbos, deep black berries and candied citrus. The palate is full and fruity with a lingering aftertaste of spice and super smooth tannins.

Rich beef stews and all duck and game dishes go very well.

about the harvest: Grapes were hand harvested at 25° Balling.

in the cellar : After harvesting the grapes were delicately crushed. Cold soaked through the night. Inoculated the next morning, pump overs every 4 hours. Lightly pressed and matured in French oak barrels for 18 months.
