

Goudini Colombard 2001

Light and fruity wine for daily use. Light and fruity tablewine that combines fruit and freshness in a 500ml bottle. Pale to mild straw-yellow with strong green tinge, almost lime green; huge whiff of green guava together with some cool green stalks, nettles and crushed leaves, very typical of this variety. Dry medium bodied with good intensity of flavour, mouthfilling crunchy greengage fruit with firm acidity. The crisp acids are well integrated and a signature note for Colombard. Serve with rich and flavourful cheese souffle calamari rings with tartar sauce, chicken Kiev (crumbed chicken breasts stuffed with garlic butter), and will be especially good with fresh oysters.
