

Oak Lane Chenin Blanc / Sauvignon Blanc 2011

This wine offers a light straw-colour with an attractive green undertone. The palate brings lovely citrus nuances and an array of tropical flavours that fuse marvellously with the underlying green pepper notes: crisp, zesty and refreshing.

Wonderful on its own but will compliment most dishes of lighter style. A true "anytime" wine!
Compliments most aperitifs, salads and seafood.
