Vineyard: Selection of Chardonnay vineyards planted on rich limestone soil in the Robertson area. The Chardonnay vineyards produce on average 10 tons per hectare.

**about the harvest:** Hand selected and hand harvested in the cool morning hours during the 18 and 19th February 2011.

**in the cellar :** The Chardonnay was destalked, gently crushed and pressed immediately. The juice was settled overnight and then transferred to stainless steel tanks for fermentation between 14° and 16°C. After fermentation the various portions of Chardonnay's were blended together.
