

De Toren La Jeunesse Délicat NV

Imagine the sensual pleasure of fresh, ripe, red strawberries combined with rose petals, marshmallows and the mystical aroma of cinnamon. The gentle tannins and delicate balance of acidity gives this wine its unique character of being fresh, youthful and light. This is a Beaujolais-style wine with attitude and depth! The flavours are playful and mischievous in the mouth with a LA JEUNESSE DÉLICAT lingering, lazy aftertaste.

The wine should be served slightly chilled (10-12 Degrees Celsius) ... perfect for an aperitif, lunchtime with salads, mezze/cheese platter, picnics or just sitting at the pool in the summer sun! Light dinner style meals such as pasta, white meat and seafood will compliment this wine.

ageing : LA JEUNESSE DÉLICAT should be enjoyed immediately, due to the low tannins. We want wine-lovers to enjoy the freshness we intended from the beginning.

in the vineyard : We have strong beliefs of producing quality only and to focus on what we are good at ... making red wine. We embrace everything about our farm and because we practice attention to detail in every aspect, we know what our terroir offers – we listen, see and learn from every vintage and by carefully assessing the information and characteristics of the berries produced, we make a wine best suited to that vineyard ... maximizing what nature provides.

in the cellar : Our traditional style of Bordeaux Blends are strong and serious, but over the last 3 years we have identified pockets within the vineyards where the specific microclimate to that patch produces lighter and softer flavours in the grape. This phenomenon gave us the opportunity to create something different ... this is how LA JEUNESSE DÉLICAT was born. This fresh and light style offers intense red undertones, but is soft and delicate in the mouth – a migration between red and white!
