

Weltevrede Place of Rocks Chardonnay 2010

A pale golden colour. On the nose you get an intense mixture of dried pear, dried apricot and ripe lemons. The very flavourful palate reveals ripe lemons and dried mango.

Thai food, lemon and olive oil infused fish and most other seafood dishes.

in the vineyard : This collection of wines is focused on the soil type of the vineyard and the effect of the soil in the end product. For Place of Rocks the broken shale adds to the minerality and the tightness that you experience in the wine.

in the cellar : Single vineyard Chardonnay. The vines are rooted in broken shale soil on a south facing slope and the wine spent 6 Months in French Oak barrels with batonnage once a week.
