Nose: Deep, concentrated flavours of brambles and red fruit. Integrated spicy notes from oak use.

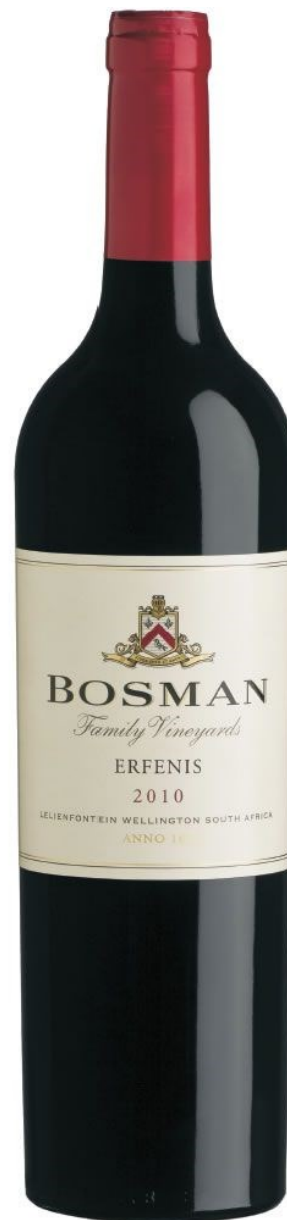
