

Raoul's Shiraz Rosé 2011

Sweet cherry and raspberry fruit on the nose. A lively palate with a zippy acid to balance the sweetness, with pure flavours that linger in the aftertaste.

The fruitiness and acidity of this Shiraz Rose will match perfectly with a grilled salmon, tuna, yellow-tail or any mild seafood dish. Also pairs well with ham, pork, and Mediterranean salads.
