

Swartland Idelia 2008

Appearance: An intense wine, brick red with orange rim gives an indication of an older wine. Clear and bright.

Nose: A complex and forthcoming nose with earthy aromas of forest floor, lively black berry fruit, sweet smelling violets and wine gums.

Palate: This is a complex wine with sweet smelling flower aromas, spices and vanilla backed by lively berry fruit. A full, rich and voluptuous wine with firm, but well-integrated tannins, beautiful oak integration and an excellent balance between fruit, tannin and wood. Long aftertaste.

Enjoy with a handmade Italian pasta or roasted lamb made in the same way this wine was created, with love and uttermost care.

in the vineyard : Dry land vines. Warm, dry summers and cold, wet winters.

in the cellar : Oak: 11 of the best barrels from the 2008 vintage in the barrel maturation cellar were selected. These wines mature for 18 months in mostly new oak, with a bit of older barrels for softness and suppleness. The selected barrels were blended together, bottled after a short settling time and bottle aged for another 18 months. This wine was not filtered, only gently racked.

Post Blending Treatment: The final product is a result of only the highest quality wines blended together, with each component bringing its own character to the final wine.
