

## KWV Concordia Red 2010

This lively red wine has aromas of red berries with subtle nuances of cigar box and wood spice. The palate is juicy; a chorus of elegantly structured tannins that meld into a generous and resonating finish.

This wine can be enjoyed on its own, with steak or any other grilled red meat dishes.

**variety** : Cabernet Sauvignon | 70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Shiraz, 15% Merlot

**ageing** : Savour this wine now or cellar it for up to four years from vintage.

**in the vineyard** : The mild growing season promoted slow ripening and maximized the development of berry flavours. Above average rainfall was recorded during this period, resulting in increased disease pressure and lower vineyard yields. Quality in general was very good, promising a range of excellent wines from KWV.

**about the harvest**: The 2010 harvest will be remembered for its erratic weather changes, which posed a challenge for winemakers and viticulturists alike. Budding occurred earlier than expected, which introduced an early start for the 2010 harvest.

**in the cellar** : The wine spent 12 months in French oak.
