

African Passion by Golden Kaan Cabernet Sauvignon 2011

Upfront fresh blackberry, cassis and cherry fruit on the nose. The palate is juicy, soft and concentrated with fruit flavour, with soft oak nuances. This wine is medium bodied, with good structure and a lingering, fruity finish.

Enjoy on its own or with beef casseroles and venison.

in the vineyard : About the area

South Africa's vineyards are mostly situated in the Western Cape near the coast. This is the southernmost region of the African continent, and has a Mediterranean type climate and diverse soils perfectly suited to quality grape production.

Vintage conditions

The 2011 harvest in The Western Cape was warmer and dryer than normal, resulting in lower yields, smaller bunches and consequently riper flavors. These seasonal conditions produced sound, fully ripe and healthy grapes, with resultant wines rich, soft and generous in flavor.
