Colour: Deep ruby red.

Nose: Rich multi-layer plums and cassis fruit.

Palate: Rich and full-bodied with loads of flavoured fruit backed by necessary tannins.

Serve with oxtail, smoked eisbein, beef stroganoff, fillet steak, roast shoulder of lamb.

in the vineyard : The grapes are from three particular vineyards in the Tulbagh valley. This enables the winemaker to produce wine with exceptional flavours and drinkability.

about the harvest: The grapes are from selected vineyards throughout the Valley. This enables the winemaker to produce wine with exceptional flavours and drinkability.

in the cellar : Grapes are fermented on the skins in stainless steel tanks and is pumped over every 4 hours. After pressing the wine went through malolactic fermentation. A combination of French and American oak staves are added for complexity.
