

Blaauwklippen Cultivar Selection Malbec 2009

This intense wine entices with whiffs of dark chocolate, mocha, rum, blue berries, vanilla and eucalyptus. The smooth tannins are evident with a complex, deep structure and a lingering fruity finish.

Char grilled beef, venison and oxtail.

in the cellar : Spontaneous fermentation after 3 days cold maceration. 7 Days skin contact after alcoholic fermentation. Spontaneous malolactic fermentation on skins. Matured in large oak vats.
