NOSE: Elegant raspberry, blackberry and concentrated plum aromas. Slight pencil shaving notes.

PALATE: Beautiful mouth feel with a long fruit packed, persistent finish.

Pair with beef, casseroles, hearty stews or as a conversation point in front of a winter's fireplace.

in the vineyard : The components for this varietal wine is from different sites in the Bovlei Valley that range from young fruit driven sites to older vineyards that expresses elegance.

in the cellar : The different vineyards's fruit is vinified separately and matured differently to form a wine which is complex from the offset. Care is taken with the tannin management to make a wine with structure, but which is also palatable.
