

## Morgenhof Estate Chenin Blanc 2000

## SOLD OUT

This wine has a pale-yellow colour. The nose has lots of flavour of limes, apricots and soft undertones of wood. The palate is crisp, fresh with lots of lemony undertones. The aftertaste is long and lingering with a very good balance between the acidity and sweetness. The wine could be drunk with many occasions, ie. Sundowners, light meals, creamy chicken dishes, soups, etc.
