

Wildeckrans Estate Pinotage 2010

From low-yielding vineyards, matured in small oak barrels for 12 months. A fruit-driven, sweet, spicy wine with good structure. Juicy with a long, lingering finish.

Seared steak with rocket and wheat salad, sizzling spare ribs with BBQ sauce or lamb skewers on the grill.

about the harvest : Grapes were harvested by hand at 25° Balling

in the cellar : After harvesting the grapes were delicately crushed. Cold soaked through the night. Inoculated the next morning, pump overs every 4 hours. Lightly pressed and matured in French oak barrels for 18 months.
