

## Thelema Mountain Red 2010

Spicy aromas of black pepper and mulberry mingle with the plum flavours in this soft and approachable wine.

Particularly good with light and medium flavoured meals, such as pizza and braai.

**variety** : Shiraz | 28% Cabernet Sauvignon, 29% Shiraz, 18% Grenache, 14% Petit Verdot, 11% Merlot, 3% Cabernet franc
