

KWV Concordia Red 2012

in the vineyard : Vintage Conditions

The winter preceding the 2012 vintage was characterised by far lower than average rainfall. This trend continued into the summer, resulting in vineyards showing signs of lower soil moisture by way of the reduced berry size and bunch weight. A cooler ripening season with even temperatures led to steady and measured ripening of the grapes. Overall, the smaller berry size and lower yields promise great concentration, good quality and intense colour in the 2012 vintage wines.

Soil in the Western Cape

Soil in the Western Cape is ancient (350 million years old) weathered soils, of alluvial or volcanic origin. The alluvial soils are from both glacial and marine deposits. Some of the origins of the weathered soils are Table Mountain Sandstone, Granite or Malmesbury Shale. These soils have eroded over millennia and are now generally clay rich loam soils, which are most desirable for their ability to retain water for plant during summer months.

in the cellar : The wine was oak matured for 10 months
