Blackcurrant, black olive, lavender and cashew characteristics. Brick red to purple; medium bodied with rounded tannins and generous length. Distinct intensity, supple consistency with a rounded structure. Harmonious with a dry finish. Overall Impression: Distinctly the 'little brother' of Die Arnoldus.
