Bordeaux-style blend with black olive, cloves, lavender and cashews characteristics. Brick red to purple; medium bodied with smooth tannins and a generous length. Pure intensity with an open and supple consistency and a dry finish.

Enjoy with tomato-based pizza or pasta; slightly spicy food such as traditional Cape Malay bobotie springrolls; bacon and egg quiche; BBQ spare ribs.
