This crisp, dry, fruit driven Sauvignon is made in a new world style. It offers lush, lively tropical fruit, zesty citrus and subtle green pepper and mineral flavours. The balanced fruit and acid, together with a rich and creamy mouth-feel, make this wine superbly complex and yet versatile. This wine is exquisite on its own but will compliment almost any dish.
