in the vineyard :

VINEYARD: North West facing

SOIL TYPE: Well drained Hutton & Glenrosa

VINEYARD AREA: Specially selected grapes from a variety of blocks

TRELLIS: Vertical shoot positioning (VSP) with 2 movable wires

IRRIGATION: At crucial times during grape development.

CLONES: SB11H, SB316, SB10B on Rootstock Richter 110

about the harvest: HARVESTED: 21 February, 24 February & 25 February.

in the cellar : All blocks fermented at 12°C separately using a variety of yeasts.
Fermentation time varied between 12 and 18 days.
