

Goudini Sauvignon Blanc 2001

Nice Fruity Style showing a range of flavours. Full mouth, youthful and rich with asparagus and subtle grassy undertone. Pale lemon yellow with strong green tint; aromatic herbal tones and a full house of greens; dusty green peppers, figs, cut grass, limes together with a touch of honey and grapefruit. Good crisp white with bright citrus and grapefruit flavours, pleasant smooth acidity adds bounce but enough fruit to ensure a soft landing. A charming wine. Drink now. Serve with steamed mussels in a lemon and cream sauce, grilled calamari drenched in garlic butter, a layered vegetarian terrine or a simple pasta with homemade sauce.
