in the vineyard : A combination of different terroirs.

about the harvest: Grapes were harvested at optimum ripeness.

in the cellar : The grapes were vinified separately. Fermentation happened in tanks over 4 - 6 days, pressed put back into tank to finish melolactic fermentation. After Melolactic fermentation the wine was raked into second and third fill barrels for 12 months until they were blended, stabilized and bottled.
