Rich ripe blackcurrants with cloves and cinnamon with a hint of menthol on the nose. Ripe plummy fruit and fine tannins create a wine to be enjoyed now or cellar for a further 2 years, but why wait, life is short?

variety : Cabernet Sauvignon | 45% Cabernet Sauvignon, 41% Merlot, 14% Cabernet Franc

in the vineyard : A combination of different terroirs.

about the harvest: Grapes were harvested at optimum ripeness in February 2011.

in the cellar : Grapes were vinified separately. Only aerated pump overs were given during the course of alcoholic fermentation to create a soft, fruit driven wine ready to be drunk young. The different varieties matured separately in tanks until they were blended, stabilized and bottled.
