Red berries and spicy. Ripe fruit and firm tannins create a wine to be drunk young and cellar for another 2 years.

variety : Merlot | 50% Merlot, 44.3% Cabernet Sauvignon, 3.6% Malbec, 2.1% Petit Verdot

winery : Diemersfontein Wine and Country Estate

in the vineyard : Situation of vineyards: A combination of different terroirs.

about the harvest : Grapes were harvested at optimum ripeness in February 2012.

in the cellar : Grapes were vinified separately. Only aerated pump overs were given during the course of alcoholic fermentation to create a soft, fruit driven wine ready to be drunk young. The different varieties matured separately in tanks until they were blended, stabilized and bottled.
