about the harvest: Date of harvest: mid-March.

Type of harvest: Hand harvest in the cool morning

in the cellar : Cold maceration for 3 days, followed by juice extraction. Pump over 3 times daily and punch down.

Temperature: 16° - 28° C.

Length: 10 - 25 days on skins

Malolactic fermentation: In stainless steel tank with wood staves.
