An elegant, medium-bodied wine with rich, intense layers of chocolate, creamy mulberry and subtle tannins, with a hint of mint on the finish.

Very versatile, but pairs best with dishes of the same intensity.

in the vineyard : Vine density – 4,500 vines per hectare

about the harvest: A fantastic red wine vintage. The grapes reached optimum ripeness with ease.

in the cellar : The best quality grapes were selected and picked at optimum tannin ripeness, gently crushed and fermented in stainless steel tanks. The wine matured for 15 months in small, third-fill French- and American oak barrels.
