Fresh red berries and sweet liquorice on the nose. A juicy and soft mouthfeel with medium weight and confident follow-through of the fresh red fruit.

in the vineyard : All grapes are from a low yielding, un-irrigated Agter-Paarl vineyard.

about the harvest: Grapes were hand-picked.

in the cellar : Grapes were fermented on the skins in stainless steel tanks. The wine was pressed on the skins and transferred to 2nd to 4th II French oak barrels. The wine was matured for 10 months before being bottled.
