

Muratie Ronnie Melck Shiraz 2010

Bright and enticing, this deep ruby red wine has an abundance of spice on the nose - lots of black and white pepper with hints of dark chocolate and rich fruit cake. The palate has plenty of black plummy fruit with some prunes, smoked meats and mulberry notes, all wrapped up in silky tannins with smoky spicy oak discreetly in the background.

A lengthy finish suggests this wine has plenty of potential for ageing for a further 5 - 8 years but if you want to enjoy it now, a charcuterie platter of free-range meats would be just the thing.

ageing : A wonderful wine now and will improve for the next 8 - 10 years.

about the harvest: The vineyards yield approximately 7 tons per Hectare. The grapes are handpicked at optimum ripeness.

in the cellar : The grapes are then gently crushed and destalked. The wine is made in traditional open fermenters which enable plunging and pump-overs to be done with ease. The wine is matured in 90% French oak (30% new) and 10% American oak barrels.
