A full bodied red wine with ripe blackberry and ripe plum flavours followed by delicate white pepper nuances on the nose and palate. Well integrated oak, soft tannins and an elegant finish, makes for a wonderful tasting experience.

Shiraz can be enjoyed with smoked meats and charcuterie, games dishes and red meat with a lovely pepper sauce.

in the vineyard : Shiraz for the Grande Provence range comes from sought after vineyards in the Stellenbosch area. A region well known for some of the best Shiraz wines in the country. This was an excellent year for Shiraz, with warm days and limited rainfall, resulting in small berries with concentrated flavour.

in the cellar : Wine was oak matured for 15 months.
