

Arniston Bay Sauvignon Blanc 2013

Generosity is the defining word for the 2012 Arniston Bay Sauvignon Blanc. Powerful, perfumed nose of sweet fruit with green pepper and grassiness. The palate is concentrated with a herbal, grassy character and thick-textured fruit. A powerful wine of real personality.

Serve chilled. This wine can be enjoyed with seafood and salads. This wine is suitable for vegetarians, but not for vegans.
