

Stonecross Sauvignon Blanc Sémillon 2014

Light yellow with green tinge. The wine has enticing tropical notes of passion fruit, pineapple and ripe kiwifruit. It is well balanced by green peppers and freshly cut grass aromas. The palate is fruity and fresh with good citrus acidity. The wine has a linear entry with a full middle palate, provided by the Sémillon. The wine has a fresh entry and a lingering aftertaste.

about the harvest: The grapes are closely monitored and harvesting took place when the balance between tropical fruit, green aromas and acidity was achieved. Picking occurred before sunrise to ensure cool grapes.

in the cellar : Modern techniques and reductive winemaking practices were used to enhance and protect the delicate varietal aromas. The Sauvignon Blanc and Sémillon are made and aged separately and blending occurred one month prior to bottling.
