

Hartenberg The Mackenzie 2008

This classically styled, richly structured wine shows strong blackcurrant notes, as well as violets and dark chocolate aromas. The palate has a mélange of vanillin oak flavours, intermingled black and red fruit.

Rich meat dishes with savoury jus, leg of lamb, sirloin on the bone with red wine jus.
