Suave and streamlined, good depth of fruit, chalky oak tannins and long finish. Confident, age-worthy style.

**variety** : Cabernet Sauvignon | 95% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Merlot

**winery** : Delheim Wine Estate

**winemaker** : Philip Costandius

**wine of origin** : Simonsberg-Stellenbosch

**analysis** : **alc** : 13.65 % vol **rs** : 2.54 g/l **pH** : 3.37 **ta** : 5.87 g/l

**in the vineyard** : From two vineyards situated on a south-westerly slope in the Muldersvlei bowl, 21-year-old bush vines.

**about the harvest**: The grapes were handpicked.

**in the cellar** :

The handpicked grapes were fermented in roto-tanks and upright fermentors with the aid of selected yeast strains. Temperature was maintained at 25-30°C. The wine was racked and returned once a day, followed by three pump-overs per day, and then matured for twenty-one months in French oak barrels (100% new).
