

Rhebokskloof Pearlstone Cabernet Sauvignon/Shiraz 2012

Ruby red colour, with typical nose of ripe Cabernet dark fruit and dried herbs. The palate is complex and fruity with nice ripe tannins and a lingering dry finish.
