

Beau Joubert Ambassador 2010

Gorgeous complex layers of dark currants, red berries, stewed fruit, subtle spices and mocha flavours linger endlessly onto a leathery, cigar-box finish. Careful oak maturation, along with silky ripe tannins and beautifully integrated acid gives this wine superb structure.

This premium wine will compliment most meat dishes but will also prove glorious on its own and dark chocolate with a high cocoa content.

in the vineyard : Merlot: west-facing slopes between 170 and 190m above sea level consisting of decomposed granite and loam soils.

in the cellar : This flagship blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and dollop of Shiraz was matured for 24 months, in a selection of new small French oak barrels.
