This intense wine entices with whiffs of dark peppermint chocolate, mocha, rum and red berries. Full bodied with rich, ripe tannins and a complex, deep structure. Generous lingering finish.

Char grilled beef, venison and oxtail. Serve at a temperature of 17° C
